

**HANSON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
SPECIAL MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS
TUESDAY, APRIL 13, 2021**

Chairman Kjetland called a special meeting of the Hanson County Drainage Board to order on Tuesday, April 13, 2021 with the following members also present: Fox, Schoenrock and Waldera. Bumgardner was absent. The County Auditor and Drainage Administrator were also present.

Motion Fox, seconded by Waldera to approve the agenda.

Today's special meeting was held to consider and approve a tabled drainage permit from April 6th.

Motion Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve permit #21-07 for Riggs Farms Inc. to replace existing clay tile and new grid tiling to the same outlet in section 21 of 102-58 as the following conditions have been met. All voted aye, motion was carried.

1. The project is not a flood hazard or affect floodplain values.
2. Minimal potential of erosion.
3. Will not affect water quality and supply.
4. Will improve agriculture production.
5. Will improve environmental quality.
6. Aesthetics will be maintained.
7. Fish and wildlife values will not be affected.
8. No adverse effects on downstream landowners as;
 - a. Sufficient capacity to handle the flow.
 - b. Improving the natural drain system and carry capacity is reasonable.
 - c. The amount of water to be drained is reasonable.
 - d. The design and physical aspects of the drain are reasonable.
 - e. The impact of sustained flow is acceptable.

There being no further business to come before the board, motion Schoenrock, seconded by Waldera to adjourn the meeting.
