

HANSON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS
Tuesday, June 15, 2021

Commissioner Waldera called the meeting of the Hanson County Drainage Board to order on Tuesday, June 15, 2021 with members Fox and Schoenrock present. Don Huber, Drainage Administrator was also present. Bumgardner and Kjetland were absent.

Motion Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve the agenda.

Motion Schoenrock, seconded by Fox to approve the June 1st meeting minutes.

No citizens input.

Just for documentation purposes requested by the City of Alexandria a motion was made by Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve permit #21-29 for Tyson Gau to widen an existing driveway, with culvert, located on 10th St. in the city limits of Alexandria. All voted aye, motion carried.

Motion Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve permit #21-30 for Millbrook Colony to Tile in section 35-104-58 as the following conditions have been met. Project does not affect government property, does not drain a fish or wild life lake, does not impact a meandered lake, does not affect another county, it does convert noncontributing land to improve contributing land, no erosion potential, no impact to water quality and supply, ag production will improve, environmental quality will improve, aesthetics will be maintained, fish and wildlife values remain the same, receiving watercourse is acceptable, drainage is a reasonable improvement and aid to the normal and natural system, drainage is a reasonable artificial drain system, the amount of water to be drained is reasonable, the design and physical aspects of the drain are acceptable, impact of sustained flow is minimal. All voted aye, motion carried.

As there was no further business before the Board, a motion was made by Schoenrock, seconded by Fox to adjourn meeting. All voted aye, motion carried.
