WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of Hanson County, AD to have the safe use of the county roads and highways within Hanson County, SD; and WHEREAS, the standard speed limit as established by the State of South Dakota is not appropriate for all of the county highways within Hanson County, South Dakota; and WHEREAS, that portion of the county highway system located on the north side of Lake Hanson could be made safer for use by establishing a lower speed limit thereon; therefore, it was moved by Pierson and seconded by Letcher, that the following Ordinance be adopted:

## COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 6

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SPEEDS ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS"
BE IT ORDAINED BY HANSON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKDTA, THAT:

- 1. The speed limit is hereby established as thirty (30) miles per hour for that portion of the county highway system located on the north side of take Hanson, in the North Half ( $N_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ ), Section Twenty-One (21), Township One Hundred Two North (102N), Range Fifty-Eight West (58W) of the 5th P.M. excepting only the following portion thereof as set out at section 2 hereof.
- 2. The speed limit is hereby established as fifteen (15) miles per hour for that portion of the county highway system located within the park area on the north side of Lake Hanson, in "the North Half ( $N_2$ ), Section Twenty One (21), Township One Hundred Two North (102N), Range Fifty-Eight West (58W) of the 5th P.M."
- 3. The maximum penalty for a violation of either of the sections of this ordinance shall be a fine of \$100.00 or thirty (30) days in the county jail, or both such fine and imprisonment, or any combination thereof.

## ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RESTRAINING AND CON-TROLLING OF DOGS IN A PART OF HANSON COUNTY, SOUTH DA-KOTA.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Hanson County, South Dakota, that:

Sec. 1. This Ordinance applied to and covers that portion of Section Twenty-One (21), Township One Hundred Two (102) North of Range Fifty-Eight (58) West of the 5th P.M., in Hanson County, SD, bounded by the following: On the north side by County Highway 05 (also known as the "Lake Road"); on the east side, by County Highway 05 where it forms the section line highway between Sections twenty-One and Twenty-Two in the Township described above; and on the south side, by the northern shore or bank of Lake Hanson and the northern bank of Pierre Creek located below the spillway to Lake Hanson in said Section Twenty-One.

Sec. 2. No person shall allow any dog which he owns or which is under his control or possession to run at large within that portion of Section Twenty-One, Township One Hundred Two North of Range, Fifty-Eight West of the 5th P.M., described above.

Sec. 3. Any person guilty of violating any of the sections of this Ordinance may be punished by a fine in an amount of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or maybe punished by imprisonment for not more than Thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 4. Each incident where this happens shall be deemed a separate violation.

Sec. 5. If any provison of this Ordiance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions fo this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
