

HANSON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS
Tuesday, June 18, 2024

Chairman Bumgardner called the meeting of the Hanson County Drainage Board to order on Tuesday, June 18, 2024 with members Fox, Kjetland, Schoenrock and Waldera present.

Motion Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Kjetland, seconded by Schoenrock to approve the June 6, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

No conflict of interest.

Camden Hofer, SPN, and Travis Kampshoff, City of Emery, brought forward the City's permit that was approved in September as the route of the storm sewers project has changed. After the new route was explained, a motion by Kjetland, seconded by Fox to approve the permit and route changes as SPN is obtaining easements from the landowners involved and the occupancy approval from the SD DOT has been obtained and will be attached to the revised permit. All voted aye, motion carried.

An additional permit from the City will be presented at the next meeting to clean the blue line creek that the Emery storm sewer will drain to.

Scott Hanson, East River Land Improvements, presented the permit for Rockport Colony to Tile in the NE4 SW4 SW4 of 2-101-59. After reviewing the permit and checklist attached, motion by Fox, seconded by Schoenrock to approve tile permit #24-23 for Rockport Colony. Waldera abstained, all others voted aye, motion carried.

The Graves/Jarding, Pollreisz, Kappenman drainage hearing was continued. After review of the testimony and permit, a motion by Fox, seconded by Waldera stating that the vested ditch cleanout application was correctly completed and formally approved by the drainage administrator. To remedy the drainage issue, Graves will need to contact Rosedale Township about increasing their culvert size to alleviate the water on the Graves property. Kjetland abstained as he was not present for the hearing, all others voted aye, motion carried. All parties involved will be notified by mail of this decision.

Motion Fox, seconded by Kjetland to postpone revising the current drainage permits until next meeting after the Board has had time to review the permits. Motion carried.

As there was no further business before the Board, a motion was made by Waldera, seconded by Fox to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
